6. Agenda

a. Old Business:

1. HCC update: The sign has been rehung. Getting estimates for new fire doors. Some interior lights were fixed. No update on the contract. Water tests have come back good, and testing is ongoing.

2. Cemetery estimates:

Motion by S. Matchinski, supported by R. Larson to accept the estimate from Manistique Tree and Fence to remove trees in the cemetery and grind down stumps. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by S. Matchinski, supported by K. Matchinski to accept the estimate from Spencer Forest Products to gravel the driveway and level the front area of the Cemetery. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Government Lots 11 & 12 on Dodge Lake:

Motion by J. Beckman, supported by S. Matchinski to accept the estimate from Spencer Forest Products to install a U-shaped driveway on the Township lots and to proceed with getting a Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control (SESC) permit from Schoolcraft Soil Conservation and a driveway permit from Schoolcraft County Road Commission. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by K. Matchinski, supported by S. Matchinski to proceed with getting a Special Use permit from Schoolcraft County Building and Zoning Department. Motion carried unanimously.

b. New Business:

1. Resolution for Hiawatha Township Zoning

Motion by K. Matchinski, supported by J. Beckman to adopt *Resolution for Hiawatha Township Zoning* to continue to allow Schoolcraft County to provide the Zoning for Hiawatha Township. Motion carried unanimously.

- **7. Assessor's Report:** Assessor not present. Report read by G. Baker: Entered all the latest deeds, PREs and address changes. Responded to all phone calls and emails. Work continues on New Construction property visits and entering information into the database. Work also continues on sales studies.
- **8. Fire Report:** No calls this month. Corey Barr reported that the PPE specs are complete and will go out for bids on Monday.
